Teri Crain showed a framed work: a vibrant, multicolored appliqué, a turtle in the center.

Chris Williams showed a large quilt she is making for her granddaughter: brightly colored dogs in doghouses. The backing is a pawprint fabric. She will be putting family dogs' names on the doghouses.

Becky Parales learned how to make a folded log cabin square in Barbara King's class. She showed two potholders which she donated to Quiltique. Also she showed a blue, red and white hand-pieced and hand-quilted quilt.

Sandi Adair donated to the Guild library quilt books scooped up for \$1 each at the Woodland Friends of the Library book sale.

Rita Eisenstat finished a quilt in reds and pinks. The blocks were from a Block-of-the-Month club at Cloth Carousel.

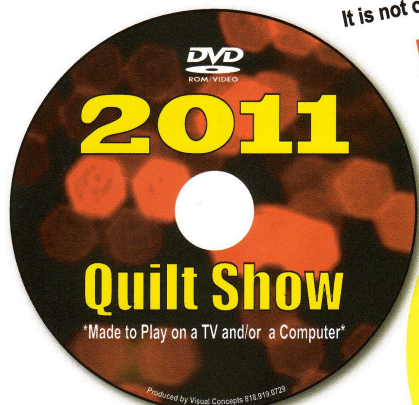
