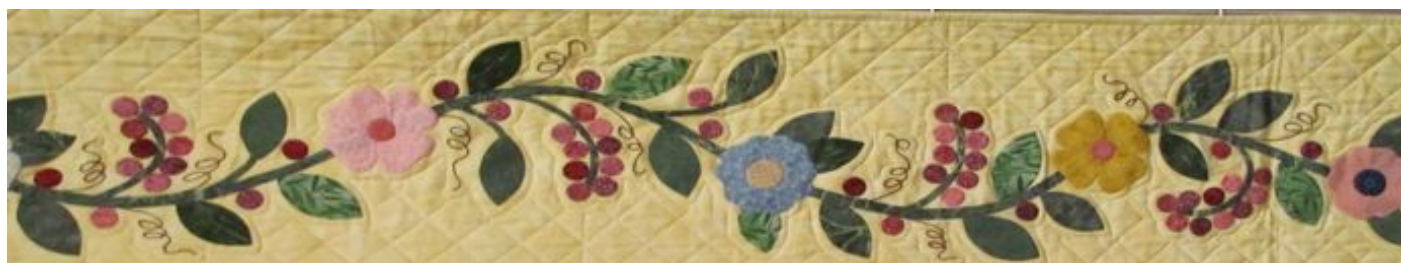

Lots of holiday quilts, a celebration of our efforts

Carol Smith: as an outgoing board member of River City quilt Guild she was given blocks-red, green and white. She said it took 11 years to figure out how she wanted to put them together.

Judy Randel: reds, greens and whites; a gigantic BOM quilt

Diane Steele: advent calendar quilt-she collects advent calendars. This was a difficult pattern. If she had known how difficult it would be she wouldn't have started (We've ALL been there!) ; a green and red quilt with beautiful dense quilting.

Wanda Richter: lots of quilts some of them printed. Santa panels and a beautiful pieced quilted Christmas design of cream green and red

Janet Wheaton: a group Christmas tree theme quilt that went all over the country

Linnie Faina: a small quilt pattern from 1998, but just made it this year

Mieke VanDenreek: Round Robin with a Home Sweet Home theme. Follow rules for row size, each person adds on about 4 by 5 feet; for her son a "guy quilt" with a subtle design in charcoal and grey.

Marcia Cary: Linus quilt (50 x70), almost finished, she started by using pieces left over from Chinese coin quilt. Small art quilt top: inspired by a semaphore poster; patchwork pins

Susan Nicol Dixon: a quilt top of leftover pieces from other quilts; Christmas tree skirt; table runners

Diane Beard: penguin quilt; stained glass quilt with rich tones; brown and white quilt; kaleidoscope quilt in red and black; and a quilt made with Japanese style fabric
