- Stitch quilt show label to lower right corner of the back of the quilt (inside of handbag).
If you don't have your original label, a copy can be obtained from the Guild's website.
- Deliver quilt show entry (entries) to the Guild's meeting location, Woodland County Fair Mall, on **Thursday, May 19, 2011, between Noon and 6 p.m.**
- Present quilt **and** Claim Check to intake person to check in your item(s); the Claim Check will be returned to you so you can pick up your quilt following the quilt show.
- Pick up your 2011 Quilt Show entry (entries) at the Yolo County Fairgrounds after the show on **Sunday, May 22, 2011, approximately 4-5 p.m.**
- You **MUST** have your Claim Check in order to receive your entry. If someone else is picking up your entry for you, that person **MUST** have your Claim Check.

NOTE PICK-UP TIME: The Quilt Show Committee found an error on the entry form Claim Check. The time for picking up entries should be approximately **4-5 p.m** on Sunday. Please make this **correction**.
